



RE: Be Vigilant Against Donation Scams in the name of Children's Cancer Foundation (CCF)

1. Children's Cancer Foundation (CCF) would like to alert the public to possible donation scams that may occur during this festive season. Scammers may impersonate CCF to solicit donations from unsuspecting members of the public.
2. Members of the public are advised to:
 - a. Check with CCF on the legitimacy of any fundraising events/campaigns in support of CCF before donating. Drop us an email at fundraising@ccf.org.sg for any queries on fundraising events.
 - b. Donate through CCF's official donation platforms. The official modes of donation to CCF are listed as below:
